Read this book to see what more than 50 kids just like you said when we asked them...




The CUC Snowy Monaro, and the schools participating in this project, are situated across Ngarigo, Bidhawal, Walgalu, and Ngunnawal lands.


We pay our respects to Elders past, present, and future.

Like Ruby says - there are just so many options!





To celebrate 10 years of supporting people in Snowy Monaro communities to live, study, and work locally, the Country Universities Centre Snowy Monaro is proud to release "I Want To Be..." - a children's book featuring the aspirations and illustrations of local kids.

From Adaminaby to Bombala, Nimmitabel to Jindabyne, and everywhere in between, 350 entries were distilled into 15 winners and 43 highly commended illustrations, as seen in this book.

Our CUC is proudly one of a large network across Australia - and it all started here in Cooma! After we opened in 2013, the model has now grown to a network of 18 other locally owned CUCs in 23 different locations across NSW, Queensland and Victoria.

The CUC initiative enables regional and rural university students to study close to home in a campus-like environment with learning facilities, computers, wifi, printers, video conferencing and support staff - all for free!
