Weekly Overview

Week 1 – Goal Setting and Exploration

- Students explore post-Year 12 options, set initial goals, and identify their interests and aspirations.

Week 2 – Pathways Overview: University & TAFE

- Students map out multiple pathways to their chosen careers and learn how to navigate entry requirements.

Week 3 – Using AI and Other Technology

- Students learn how to use AI responsibly for applications, interviews, and online career tools.

Week 4 – Applications & Admissions

- Students compile essential documents, refine resumes, and practice answering application questions.

Week 5 – Scholarships & Financial Support

- Students explore financial aid options, scholarships, and Centrelink support to plan for future costs.

Week 6 – Future Focus: Gap Years & Jobs

- Students consider alternative pathways, including employment and gap years.

Your facilitator is Han Worsley – qualified teacher, pathways expert, Masters student, and CUC Education Coordinator.



Expectations

- Attend each weekly session, and participate in the activities – there is no compulsory homework!
- Communicate early about attendance issues, directly to Han on 0472 737 143
- Bring your own device (a phone is fine), a notebook, and a pen each week.

FAQs

Do I have to apply to attend?

Yes! The application is quick and easy, and makes sure we can fit all students in our small rooms.

What if I don't know what I want to do next year?

This program is especially useful for people like you. We help you work through your goals and strengths to open doors. There is no expectation you choose at any point!

Can anyone apply?

Not quite – you have to be a current Year 12 student at any school in the Snowy Monaro region.

What do I get out of compelling the program?

- Expert guidance to lower the stress of Year 12.
- Recognition through a certificate, acknowledged by several universities as an extra-curricular activity.
- The ability to reach out to the CUC beyond the program, who can help with scholarships, applications, and study.

Apply and Get Support



Since 2023, the CUC has supported over 80 Year 12 students through Transition Toolkit. Of these students:

- 100% of those who applied got early entry at the university of their choice
- 12 went on to TAFE and/or apprenticeships
- 98% say the program boosted their resume and would help them get a job, scholarship, or degree offer

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
