CUC Snowy Monaro (CUCSM) is a not-for-profit organisation that is led by our Centre Manager and a skills-based, volunteer Board of Directors. The Centre exists to provide quality education opportunities to students who are studying in our local region, no matter which higher education provider or course they are engaged with. We strongly believe that the future of an aspiring student should not be determined by where they live; nor should their career aspirations be limited by proximity to learning opportunities.

OUR AFFILIATED NETWORK

The Country Universities Centre excels in its collaborative network strategy, bringing high-quality higher education to regional communities. With more than 20 study centers across over 30 communities in regional NSW, VIC, QLD, TAS and Norfolk Island, our network fosters communication and collaboration among them.

The network operates in an umbrella model, where each Centre who affiliates with Country Universities Centre is given access to the expertise and experience of the network through collaboration. Although each Centre is locally governed and driven by its community through an independent Board of Directors, the network approach means that our Centres and their students are collectively represented by an aggregated body. The benefits result in increased access to higher education in regional Australia.

The network approach allows communities to leverage off existing knowledge, share practices and collaborate to create unique and innovative solutions to increase access to higher education in regional Australia

We know that those living in country areas like ours are less than half as likely to obtain a degree in contrast to their metropolitan counterparts



Our Centre aims to improve access and choice by offering free services and supports for those pursuing further education in the Snowy Monaro. We know that a lack of face-to-face support, poor access to quality technology, and access to a quiet and distraction-free study environment are key challenges for the typical student who is studying in a regional context. CUCSM work to overcome these barriers by improving the student experience. This translates into increasing the quantity and quality of graduates located within the region.

CUCSM is part of a larger network of regionally located study communities designed for registered students to excel within a supportive environment. This includes having access to advanced technology, face-to-face supports, a cohort of fellow students, and quality academic advice. As equity in learning is a paramount value in our organisation, our services are offered to all eligible students free of charge.

Any student who is enrolled to study any qualification is welcome to use our service.

OUR BEGINNING



Like many regional and rural communities, Cooma faced challenges in providing access to quality tertiary education opportunities and contributing knowledge and qualifications into the local workforce. In 2013, the establishment of the Cooma Universities Centre was funded by Snowy Hydro Limited, Cooma Monaro Shire Council (as it was then known), and key community members to support local students in achieving their educational aspirations. And so, our incredible journey to change the future of regional education began.

Over a decade on, the expanded and rebranded Country Universities Centre is a government-funded network of 20+ Centres operating in communities across NSW, QLD, VIC and TAS.

Alongside State Government seed grants in recognition of the Centre's impact, CUC Snowy Monaro has secured funding under the Federal Regional University Study Hubs program. This program has placed the Study Centre model in the national spotlight, with Regional University Study Hubs emerging all across Australia, all developed for their local community by their local community.

CUCs operate in communities where universities cannot or will not go, from the coast to the outback, with the common goal of developing equitable access to higher education.

CUC communities have the following characteristics:

- Strong local community support
- High representation of students from equity groups such as Regional, low socioeconomic status (SES), and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- Low levels of higher education participation and bachelor attainment rates in the region
- Clear regional development goals

OUR STUDENTS



Our students choose to study a diverse range of courses from over 40 different Australian universities and many other education or training providers. We even have a small number of international students who have moved to our Region to be a part of the Snowy Hydro 2.0 Scheme.

CUC Snowy Monaro (CUCSM) has responded to our local student needs and established an innovative model that can support any student studying any course through any educational or training provider. The wrap-around model for student support provides face-to-face academic, well-being, technological, and administrative support in addition to what each student's university already provides. These extra layers of support are crucial for many students who study with us.

Regional and online students, often from low SES backgrounds or being the first in their family to pursue higher education, face higher attrition risks. This is compounded by caring and parenting responsibilities they may have. We aim to overcome these barriers by offering a free and welcoming place to study with flexible and personalised face-to-face support within our local learning community.

Our Study Centre aims to empower students to enroll in the course of their choice from any educational or training provider, with the knowledge they will be supported locally. The focus on face-to-face support provided by our team is highly valued by students. In the 2022 Student Experience Survey, 92% of students indicated they are more likely to continue with their studies because of the help they received from CUCSM staff, while 87% of our students experienced a sense of belonging, and 99% of students found the staff to be very or extremely helpful.

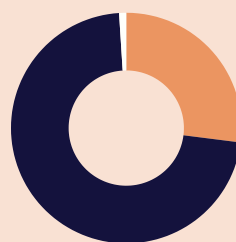

During our twelve years of supporting Snowy Monaro's local and visiting students, we have achieved some amazing results!

Since 2013, over 800 students have registered to use our facilities and services and approximately 31% of these students were the first to ever study at a tertiary level. 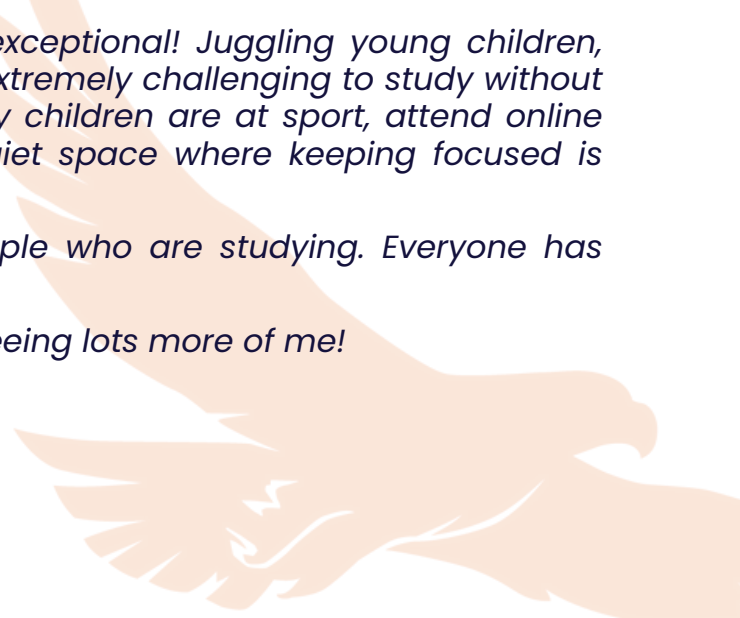
